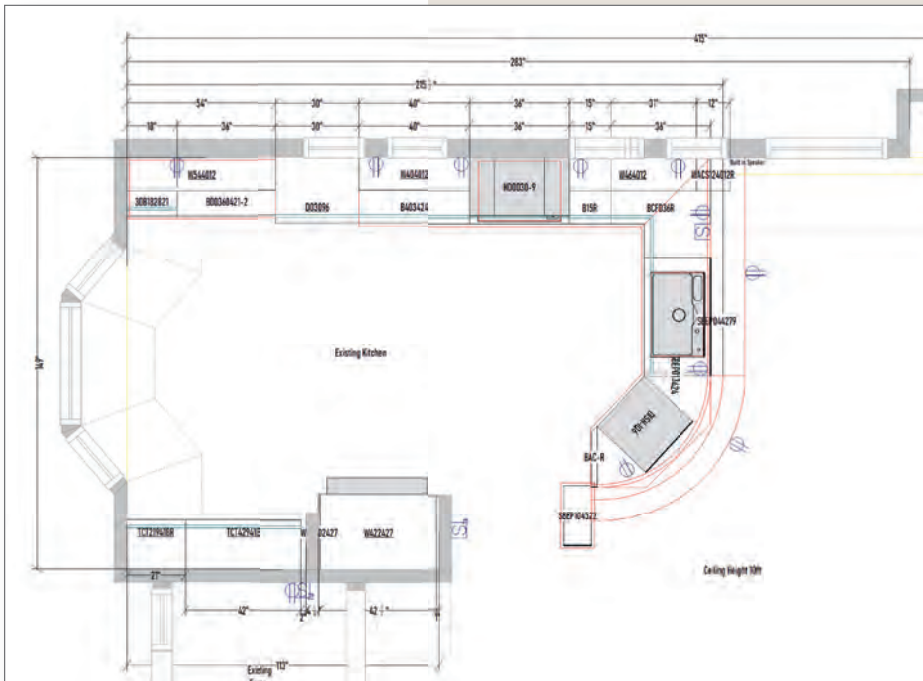

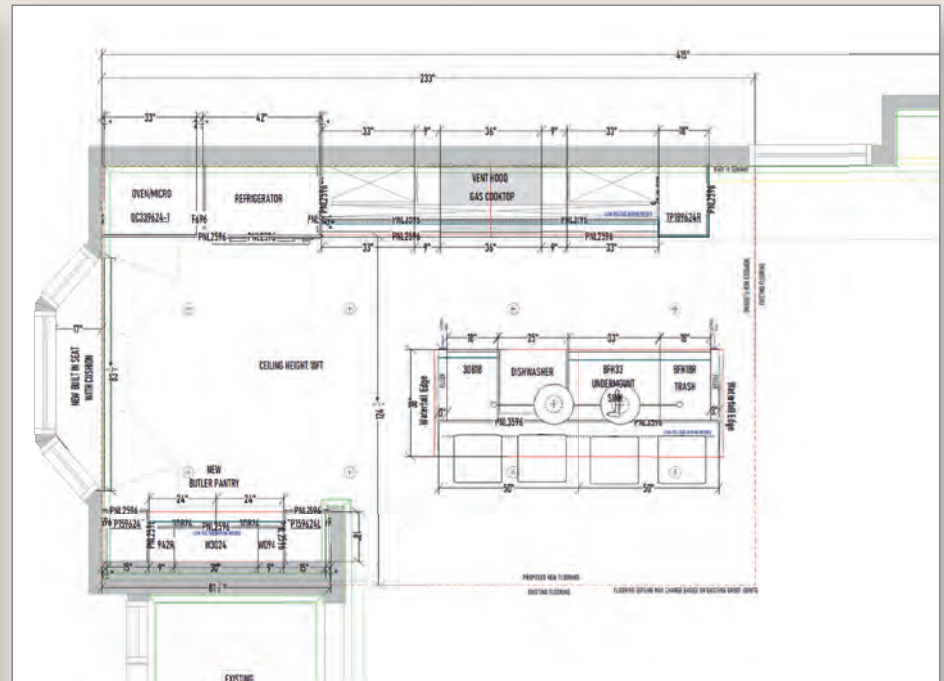

FUNCTIONALITY

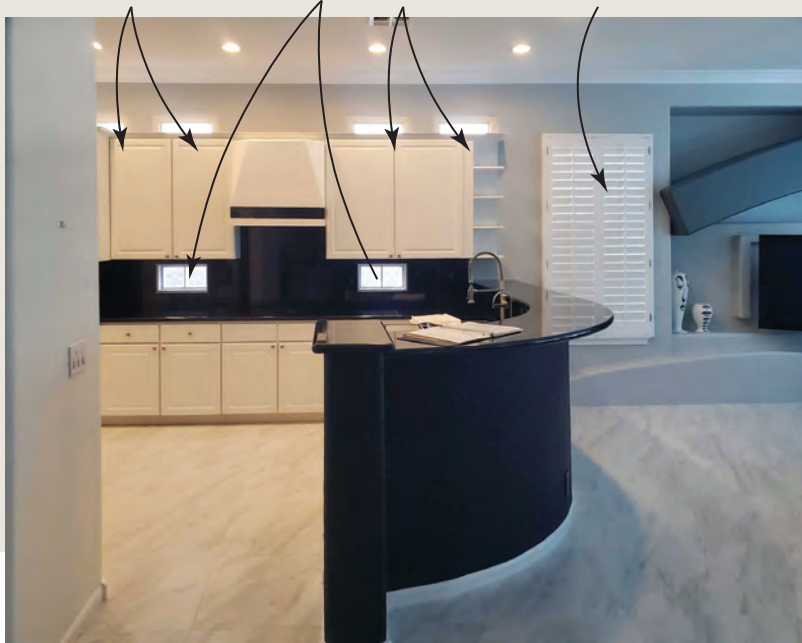
A bulky two-level peninsula was replaced with a spacious island, improving flow, function, and everyday usability. Removing the small decorative windows allowed for sleek, modern cabinetry that maximizes storage and style. High wall false panels add dramatic impact, while lower cabinetry provides accessible storage. Large-format tile in a clean stack-bond pattern defines the space with durable, low-maintenance appeal. The refrigerator was relocated beside the double oven for better workflow, and high-end appliances were seamlessly integrated into the streamlined cabinetry, creating a modern kitchen designed for function and ease.

Removing the windows required exceptional craftsmanship to ensure the filled-in windows blended seamlessly, appearing as though they were never there.



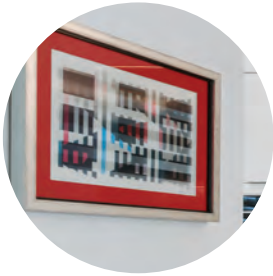
One of the best parts of this kitchen remodel was removing the small, decorative windows that distracted from the overall design. Filling them in allowed for a full wall of sleek slab-panel cabinetry, creating clean lines and a more cohesive, visually balanced kitchen.

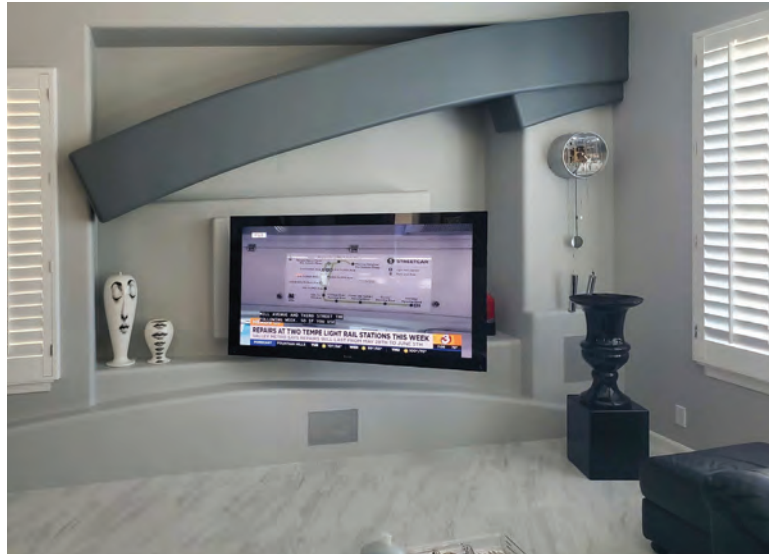

During the kitchen renovation, we found an innovative way to preserve and relocate this meaningful piece. The paintbrush sculpture, mounted directly on drywall, was carefully removed with the wall section intact, then reframed with glass and illuminated by a gimbal light, honoring her husband's creativity and keeping his presence a lasting part of the home.

INNOVATION

The client remained in her home throughout the remodel, so we created a containment area to prevent dust from spreading while allowing her to comfortably use adjacent spaces. Integrated air filters maintained proper airflow, ensuring the environment stayed clean and dust-free during construction.
